## ORDINANCE NO. 2014-7

## PROHIBITION OF FIREWORKS AND FIRES DURING THE DROUGHT PERIOD OF 2014

THIS ORDINANCE REGULATES FIRES AND THE USE OF FIREWORKS IN COALVILLE CITY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COALVILLE, UTAH ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- I. <u>PURPOSE OF THIS ORDINANCE</u>. The provisions and prohibitions hereinafter contained and enacted are in pursuance of and for the purpose of securing and promoting the public health and general welfare of persons in Coalville City in their use of fires and fireworks in Coalville City as to:
  - A. Provide for safety and to prevent fire hazards;
  - B. Eliminate damage to property, animals, humans and any flammable materials as a result of fires and fireworks;
  - C. Provide safe conditions in Coalville City during times of extreme fire danger that may be exacerbated by the use of flares and fireworks;
  - D. Reduce the need to expend taxpayer funds to contain fires that could be ignited by use of flares and fireworks in a drought stricken area; and
  - E. Reduce exposure of Coalville City to personal injury and property damage claims.
- II. <u>PROHIBITION OF FIRES AND FIREWORKS</u>. It is unlawful for any person to initiate burning, have campfires or use any type of fireworks within the Coalville City limits commencing on the twenty-ninth day of July, 2014 and continuing indefinitely until the ban is lifted by the Coalville City Council.
- III. <u>PERMITTED CAMPFIRES</u>. Notwithstanding Section II above, campfires are permitted in designated fire pits where there are reasonable and adequate protections from flammable materials. Professionals that are engaged to provide fireworks in connection with the Summit County Fair or other municipal events are exempted from the prohibition.
- IV. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect on the twenty-ninth day of July, 2014.

V. <u>PENALTIES AND FINES</u>. Any person violating this Ordinance by creating fires or by using fireworks of any kind shall be subject to a fine of up to one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and may be assessed the cost of containing the fire and all damages resulting from the fire or fireworks.
